About Concussions

Although there are many things that can cause a concussion, more than half suffered in children are due to falls. Other causes of concussions include bike and car accidents, playground injuries or athletic injuries while playing sports, such as football, soccer or cheerleading. If you suspect that your child may have suffered a concussion, seek medical attention immediately.

Common concussion symptoms include:

- Loss of consciousness (but not always)
- Headache or similar feeling of pressure in the head
- Inability to recall events prior to and immediately following the injury
- Nausea or vomiting
- Confusion or sluggishness in conversation
- Sensitivity to light or noise
- Problems with balance or vision
- Drowsiness or inability to wake up
- Restlessness or agitation

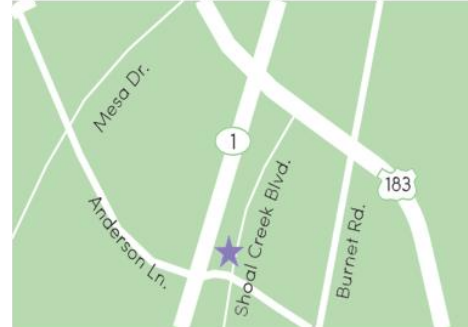
- Initial appointments within 72 hours of contacting our practice and ongoing follow-up care.
