# Over the counter pain management

Date:	

Tylenol (acetaminophen) and Advil, Motrin (ibuprofen) are safe and effective pain medications for your child when taken in correct dosages. Ibuprofen can only be used for patients 6 months or older. These medications are available over the counter (without a prescription). They are strong enough to provide pain relief after most surgical procedures. Alternating these medications on a set schedule has been proven to provide better pain control than either medication alone.

Give your child acetaminophen and ibuprofen alternating medication every 3 hours until your child is pain-free. Providing medicine 24 hours a day will help control your child's pain. By the second day, most children only use the pain medication if needed.

Example: At 9 a.m., give acetaminophen. At noon, give ibuprofen. At 3 p.m., give acetaminophen. At 6 p.m., give ibuprofen. At 9 p.m., give acetaminophen. At midnight, give ibuprofen.

#### **TYLENOL (ACETAMINOPHEN) DOSAGE CHART:**

Please refer to the table below for correct dosage. You may repeat the dosage every 4 to 6 hours as needed. Do not give acetaminophen more than five times a day. If you have been prescribed hydrocodone/acetaminophen (Hycet or Norco), do not give acetaminophen with either of those products as they both contain acetaminophen.

## **ADVIL, MOTRIN (IBUPROFEN) DOSAGE CHART:**

Do not give ibuprofen to children under 6 months of age. Determine the correct dosage by finding your child's weight in the table below. You may repeat the dosage every 6 to 8 hours as needed.
