- CAMP's mission is to strengthen and inspire individuals with special needs through recreation, respite and education.
- CAMP is a summer camp for children and adults with special needs.
- It is a residential camp starting on Sunday and ending on Friday.
- The nine different weeks are separated by disability and age.
- Children receiving agency funding are charged full price. Other siblings without funding may use the Scholarship Tier option based on their family income.

- CAMP offers scholarships to all campers not funded by an agency or by full parent payment. Scholarships are offered based on family income. Proof of income must be submitted with your application. Please see our Scholarship Tier online.
- To use agency funding, CAMP needs a letter from the case manager stating that the agency will be responsible for payment. They need an agency contact name, phone number and billing address included in the letter. Your case manager may fax this authorization letter to 210-671-5244.
